



Hemophilia Summer Camp Session at The Painted Turtle July 10-15, 2008

- Campers must be between the ages of 7 and 16 at the time of camp.

The Painted Turtle is located in Lake Hughes in the Antelope Valley, 40 miles north of Los Angeles. It's a beautiful facility with a fully equipped medical center and temperature controlled cabins, as well as a pool, gym, ropes course, woodshop, arts and crafts cabin and a lake for boating and fishing. Our staffing ratio is one staff member for every two campers.

In addition to a full time medical staff, pediatric medical specialists are on site during the camp week to provide first rate medical care.
